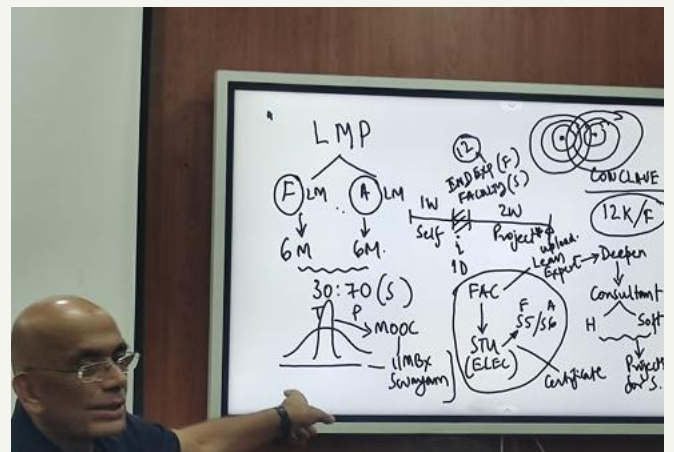
LEAN MANUFACTURING

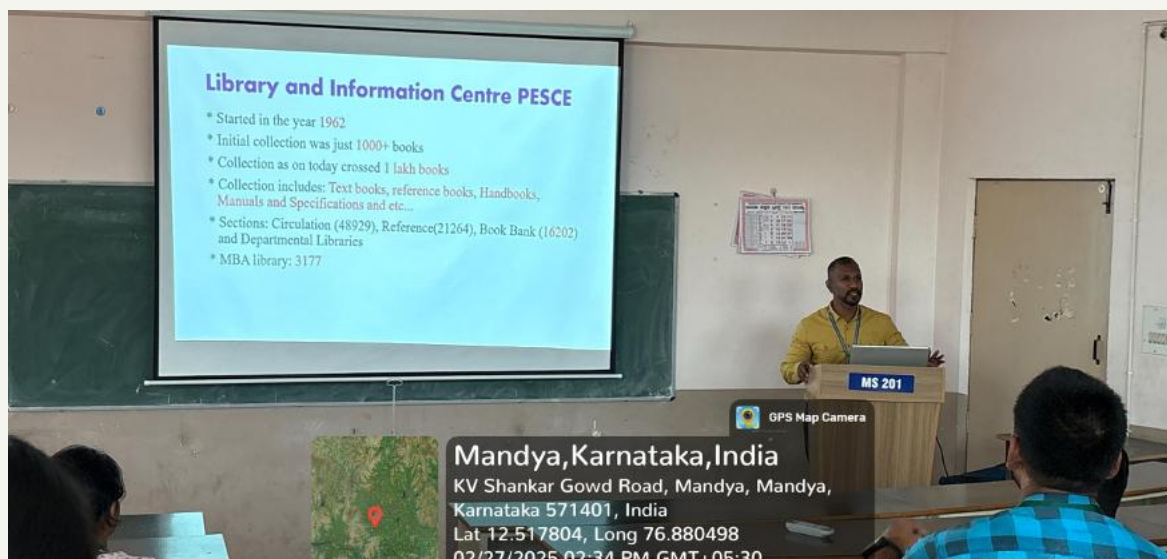
BLOOD DONATION CAMP ON 30.08.2025
