- To make the library professionals and faculty technically sound so as to automate their library independently
- To develop the online application with the help of content management system
- To enable the Library & Information Professionals to face the technological challenges such as installation, data migration, multi-branch handling etc..

DSpace is a groundbreaking Digital Library System (DLS) to capture, store, index, preserve and redistribute all scholarly research material in digital formats.

DSpace is popular software to develop Institutional Repositories, in any formats like –text, video, audio, and data. It indexes work, so as to search and retrieve the items easily. It preserves digital work over long term. It also provides a way to manage research materials and publications professionally, to give them greater visibility and accessibility over time.

**Joomla** : Joomla is an Open Source Content Management System (CMS) used all over the world for everything from simple to complex websites. It is easy to install, simple to manage, and highly reliable.

## Library & Information Centre PES College of Engineering, Mandya

The institution has a good central library housed in Administrative block and occupies total area of 13099.38 sq ft. The three sections in the library are lending, reference and book bank sections. 100 students can study in the library at a time. The library is a hub of information our institution, meeting the emerging needs. It encourages and supports the process of self learning.

The institute Library is fully automated. Books are bar coded and classified as per Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC). All the transactions (Issue/Return/Renewal) are fully computerized. Students/Staff are issued with Bar coded ID cards.

The library has a collection of about 99574 volumes including good collection of prescribed text books, reference books. It has subscribed to over 113 National journals & 12 International journals, 25 periodicals, Data hand books, Dissertation reports of BE, MTech., MCA, MBA and Doctoral works, etc.

The library has a separate digital library equipped with collection of 3000 CDs and separate browsing centre and internet facilities.

A separate wing of the library is catering to the needs of the MBA Program.

### Special Facilities

- The library has internet facility with a LAN of 30 users
- It has subscribed to many online journals- SD, ASME, ASCE, IEEE Springer, Emerald Mgt, J-Gate (Management & Engg.), Mc Graw Hill, ASTM Digital Library.
- A separate server to host institutional repositories such as lectures notes/ question papers/project reports/ Journals published by the members of the library is under development.
